Language Requirements	A B1 level of English is mandatory to attend the Bachelor's and Master's Degree.
Academic Requirements	Students will have to choose courses from the list published on the website of WIT and then agreed upon in the bilateral agreement. The WIT is rather a small school which is a part of the Systems Research Institute of Polish Academy of Sciences.



	Erasmus students, who want to come to the WIT, are provided with individual curriculum - the courses chosen and agreed in Learning Agreement. They study with individually tailored program based on the plan of seminars (or tutorials) with teachers.
Registration	Before the arrival, Erasmus students have to complete an on-line application and deliver the required documents. When they arrive, the students have to visit the Erasmus+ Coordinator (2 nd floor, room no 229), register in the WIT system UBIK and enroll the subjects of their Learning Agreement in the proper Faculty.
