

Language policy

Linguistic preparation of students is a key element in the success of mobility and its effects. To determine the level of language competence achieved by students WIT in Warsaw uses European Framework of Reference for Languages (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages). The system determines what skills and abilities the learner must acquire a foreign language to communicate in the language proceeded and ended in success.

WIT has highly qualified teachers whose skills contribute to the achievement of high results in the study of foreign languages. Classes are modern, dynamic, using the latest methods of teaching foreign languages.

At WIT in Warsaw students can study languages: English, German, French and Russian. Teaching is at levels A1, A2, B1, B2. During the course students also learn the specialized language – in compliance with their field of study (Business English). Foreign students can attend classes in Polish language.

The University is an accredited test center of TOEIC. It offers students the opportunity to certify their level of English language.

Students at WIT have also an extra chance to improve foreign language through the international exchange of students while studying in foreign universities.

The Department of Foreign Languages also organizes the Polish language courses for foreigners on all levels of competence with some elements of basic knowledge of Polish culture. The course guarantees the highest level of teaching thanks to outstanding academic staff and professional teaching facilities, flexibility and individual attitude to students.
